DAY AND TIME OF CLASSES WILL BE POST-ED AT THE DANCEWEAR SWAP AND SALE

Movers & Groovers - open to 3 year olds. This class is designed with the capability, imagination and creativity for your 3 yr. old. Using fun and innovative exercises, we introduce children to early dance steps and skills.

Creative Movement - open to 4 yr olds. A joyful way for children to explore movement through music and develop basic dance skills.

Intro to Ballet - open to 5,6,and 7 year olds. Students will be instructed and receive a foundation of Ballet technique.

Tap - available to children 5 yrs and up. Students will be instructed in the basics of Tap Dancing technique.

Intro to Jazz/Hip Hop/Ballet - ages 5 to 8 students will be instructed in all disciplines and receive a foundation of dance techniques.

Street Jazz/Jazz/Hip Hop - available to children 8 years and up. Students receive instruction in a combination of disciplines ranging from Jazz, Jive, Swing, Funk, Broadway, and Music Videos focusing on urban contemporary movements.

Tap/Street Jazz Combination Classes - available for children 5 to 8 yrs of age. This combination class divides its time between the Jazz/Hip hop and Tap disciplines.



<u>PAYMENT PROCEDURE POLICY</u> - E-Transfer, Cash or cheques are accepted.

Regular classes - there are two ways to pay.

1. Payment in full at registration (must be paid within two weeks of start up).

2. A deferred payment plan of half the tuition paid at the start of the year with a postdated cheque for January 1st.

Additional classes are on a graduated system, the more classes you take the price of the classes are reduced.

<u>Movers & Groovers and Creative Movement</u> - There is no deferred plan full payment is due at registration

Class availability is on a first come first serve basis. There is a limit to the number of students per class.

There is discount for early registration

DRESS CODE POLICY- Proper dancewear is required for participating. Failure to do so will result in not being allowed in class. Hair must be secured.

Movers & Groovers / Creative Movement - Students require a leotard with nude tights, black ballet skippers. A proper ballet skirt may be worn in class.

<u>Ballet</u> - students require a leotard, nude tights and black ballet slippers

Street Jazz & Hip Hop - Students have a choice of leotard with nude tights, or yoga pants with a dance "T". Sweatpants are not acceptable. Black jazz oxfords (preferred) or black ballet slippers are required

<u>Tap</u> - The dress code is the same as Street Jazz/ Hip Hop. Tap only classes require non-riveted tap shoes.

COSTUMES Students will have two costumes (except for Movers & Groovers and Creative Movement). A costume deposit will be requested in November. Every effort is made to keep the costume costs at a minimum. The average cost of a costumes is around \$40.00. There may be rental costumes, depending on class. If a black leotard is required it is the students responsibility to have one.
